

## Bye-Law No. 4

## Registration of Students and the Provision of Educational and Other Services by The University of Wolverhampton

- 1. Every student of the University of Wolverhampton ("the University") is required:
  - (a) To enrol formally as defined at each stage of the course as a student of the University; and
  - (b) At that time to sign the enrolment document or accept an undertaking via the University's designated online enrolment portal -
    - (i) To abide by the bye-laws, regulations, policies, rules, Codes of Conduct and admissions terms and conditions laid down by the University, and
    - (ii) To pay or cause to be paid to the University by the due dates all academic and non-academic fees and charges due to the University.
- 2. The University reserves the right to withhold the provision of all University services for any student who fails to enrol or agree to the admissions terms and conditions.
